7. ORDINANCE amending and supplementing Chapter 383 (Parks, Municipal) of the Code of the Township of Toms River, New Jersey. FINAL

8. ORDINANCE amending Section 477-59 (Schedule I: No Parking) of Chapter 477 (Vehicles and Traffic) of the Code of the Township of Toms River, Ocean County, New Jersey, in order to eliminate a parking restriction on the west side of Ocean Terrace from Sixth Avenue to Seventh Avenue. FINAL
